Postponed - Thorpe Annual Parish Meeting Tuesday 5th May 2020

Due to the Corona Virus Lock Down and in accordance with Government Guidelines the Annual Thorpe Parish Council Meeting has been postponed.

The following items have been agreed by Thorpe Parish Council.

1. Chairman and Vice Chairman – Andrew Bock to stay as Chairman on for another year and that Cat Garrett remains as Vice Chair.
2. New Parish Councillor – Phil Lee has kindly offered to join the Parish Council – we look forward to him being involved.
3. Lock Down – It was noted that as of 23rd April more visitors were passing through Thorpe to get to Dovedale. It was therefore unanimously agreed to cordon off the benches together with the car park adjacent to the former public toilets. A “Stay Safe, Stay Home” sign has been erected at the entrance to the village. This is for the safety of the villagers.
4. End of year accounts – A 2 month extension of time has been agreed by the regulators. The accounts will go to the independent auditor for approval as usual.
5. Telephone Kiosk – the paint will be purchased with the intention that volunteers will paint it subject to obeying social distancing rules. It will be cordoned off with tape.
