ON-GOING MATTERS

• 30 mph signs

A petition has been carried out, resulting in 84% positive return in favour of the 30mph signs being re-located.

This will now be sent to D.C.C. Highways, with a letter requesting their previous decision be overturned.

• Re-surfacing of lane behind Church

A site meeting was held recently, comprising of Rob Greatorex, D.C.C. Darren Sully, Severn Trent, 2 Residents & Cllr W. Smith.

The result being D.C.C. pay 1 share of the total cost, Severn Trent pay 2 shares, & the 2 residents take 2 shares. As the funding is now available, the re-surfacing can now commence. Cllr M. Ellis thanked Cllr W. Smith for his work on this project.

• Road maintenance/repairs

Cllrs attended a "village walk" accompanied by a D.C.C. representative to outline the long term road maintenance need.
