##### **1057. Minutes**

##### **1058. Ongoing Matters**

- Village website – We display the accounts information required
- Closure of public conveniences – Derbyshire Dales District Council has confirmed the closure of the toilets from 14<sup>th</sup> May. This is following the public consultant undertaken in March. There is concern that people visiting and working in the area will not have such a facility and relieve themselves

regardless. The Chairman to contact DDDC to see if the Parish can operate the service on the basis that the Parish is paid to do this.

- BT Telephone Box closure. The agreement to purchase the telephone box for £1 was signed at the meeting. Once completed and the service removed the telephone box will be repainted and it is likely that a library will be offered.
- Peveril Hill Telecom works. Now that the works are completed Kelly Communication are to be reminded that they are to tidy up the area and grass seeded.
- Potholes/road maintenance – Despite informing the County Council of the disrepair of the roads and increasing number of potholes little work has been undertaken
- Flooding on Digmire Lane – No obvious resolution. The County Council to be contacted again.
- Village Local Plan signage – The maps are ready to be erected.
- Defibrillator – The code to the cabinet is displayed in the village hall window
- Dog mess around the village. This appears to be under control with most dog owners being responsible.
- Parked cars reducing visibility when exiting Digmire Lane. The Highways Authority do not regard this as a hazard. We will erect “No Parking” signage
