#### **1077. Minutes**

#### **1078. Ongoing Matters**

- Village website – No further news. As Councillor A. Wager will be retiring in May 2019 he agreed to look after the website until 2020 when the current subscription ends. Thereafter the domain will need to be moved to an alternative domain.
- Closure of public conveniences – No further news regarding the sale. The Dove Dale Dash provided eight portable toilets but this was still not enough to cater for the numbers of people involved.
- BT Telephone Box closure – The closure has been confirmed and the telephone has been removed. Electricity continues to be provided. Quotes for redecoration to be obtained in the spring and thereafter the telephone box to be used as a book lending facility.
- Potholes/road maintenance – Works done to potholes towards Thorpe Mill and the cattle grid is being replaced in this location.
- Flooding on Digmire Lane/Hall Lane – Nothing to report.
- New Councillors for May 2019 – Nominations for new Councillors to be encouraged.
- Grounds Maintenance – The Chairman expressed his thanks to Cyril Challinor for his work this year. It was noted that verges are overgrown outside a number of properties. It was requested that owners behind verges trim in these locations.

- Peveril Hill BT works/broadband – Nothing to report.
- Proposed telephone pole at the end of Church Lane – Nothing to report.
